AQUAMATE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Preparation: First, vacuum carpet thoroughly.
2. Set the faucet between warm and cold. Hot water could damage your carpet. Fill the AquaMate tank. There is no fill line, however, fill the tank at least half full.
3. Place the AquaMate tank on the dolly of the Rainbow. Then, place the EMPTY Rainbow water basin on the AquaMate tank. (This is where the water will go that is extracted from the carpet.) Next, place the Rainbow on the water basin and latch together.
4. Fill the AquaMate bottle with shampoo. There is no fill line, so put in as much as you feel you will need. More shampoo can be added if needed.
5. Attach the AquaMate bottle to the AquaMate handle.
6. Attach the attachment hose to the handle of the AquaMate. In order to do this, you have to first remove the metal wand from the attachment hose. At times, this may be hard to remove. It will come apart, but you may have to twist, pull or tug.
7. Attach the clear tube that comes out of the AquaMate handle down to the AquaMate head.
8. Attach the attachment hose to the Rainbow.
9. Plug the electric cord from the AquaMate tank into the receptacle above the attachment hose.
10. Attach the double clear tubing to the bottom of the AquaMate tank receptacle.
11. Plug the Rainbow into the electrical wall outlet. Turn the Rainbow on to start shampooing.
12. Turn the knob on the AquaMate handle to the "bubble" picture. This will start the shampoo process.
13. Place the AquaMate head on the carpet and engage the trigger to release the shampoo and the water together.

14. Now you are ready to shampoo as shown in the picture. Frequently empty the water in the Rainbow water basin so it does not over fill.
15. To rinse, turn the knob to the picture with the “bubbles with a line through it”.
16. Rinse as shown in the picture.

CLEAN UP AND STORAGE

1. Empty the Rainbow water basin.
2. Empty the remaining shampoo back into the shampoo container.
3. Rinse the shampoo bottle thoroughly.
4. Fill the shampoo bottle with clear water.
5. Attach the shampoo bottle to the AquaMate handle.
6. Take the AquaMate head and put it over the sink, pull the trigger to rinse the shampoo from the tubes.
7. Disassemble the AquaMate for next usage.
8. Store the unit with the shampoo knob at the picture with the “bubbles with a line through it”.
